

Pulmonary Telemedicine

- ## Advantages
- Dedicated time to your patient's case
 - Less wait for a pulmonary appt. Current wait time close to 4 months
 - Less travel or extent of time spent away from home for your patient = less stress, less money spent

- ## Store and Forward
- Spirometry for interpretation
 - Example: Mrs. X presented with a cough * 2 years, this is her spirometry. She never smoked. Can you help advise further work up and management
 - Imaging with a question
 - Example: Mr. X presented with hemoptysis * 5 days, this is his Xray. What should I do next and should he be evaluate

Store and Forward

- Information needed:
 - Pulmonary Symptoms: cough, wheeze, hemoptysis, dyspnea on exertion/rest
 - Pertinent review of symptoms – eg. Weight loss
 - Pertinent Medical hx: asthma, previous lung ca
 - Imaging/spirometry
 - Smoking hx with quantity
 - TB history status

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Video teleconference

- Patient in room with audio stethoscope
- Imaging if unable to telerad
- Open to all pulmonary scenarios

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
